

Native Spring Flowers

The following are native (mostly) spring flowers listed in approximately the order in which they bloom. Common names are from Peterson & McKenny. Flower color is given.

April - May - Many of these will be found blooming before the trees leaf out.

Skunk Cabbage - *Symplocarpus foetidus* - green/brown

Coltsfoot - *introduced* - *Tussilago farfara* - yellow

Bloodroot - *Sanguinaria canadensis* - white

Round-Lobed Hepatica - *Hepatica americana* - white, lavender

Spring Beauties - *Claytonia virginica* - white, blue stripes

Rue-Anemone - *Anemonella thalictroides* - white

Dwarf Ginseng - *Panax trifolius* - white

Trout Lilly - *Erythronium americanum* - yellow

Duchman's Breeches - *Dicentra cucullaria* - white

Field Chickweed - *Cerastium arvense* - white

Early Saxifrage - *Saxifraga virginensis* - white

Barren Strawberry - *Waldsteinia fragarioides* - yellow

Early Meadow-Rue - *Thalictrum dioicum*

Wood Anemone - *Anemone quinquefolia*

Jack-in-Pulpit - *Arisaema triphyllum* - green/brown
